7 8 9 10 11 12	Until the first Wednesday of January 1987, the Governor receives an annual salary of \$35,000. Beginning the first Wednesday of January 1987, the Governor is entitled to receive an annual salary of \$70,000. Beginning the first Wednesday of January 2027, the Governor is entitled to receive an annual salary of \$125,000 and an expense account of \$40,000 annually that, notwithstanding Title 36, Part 8, is not considered income for state income tax purposes.
13	SUMMARY
14 15	This bill increases, effective January 2027, the salary for the Governor to \$125,000. It also allows the Governor to receive a nontaxable expense account of \$40,000 annually.
