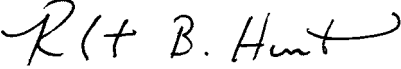

1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §802, sub-§4-B, ¶B**, as repealed by PL 2019, c. 154, §9, is
3 reenacted to read:

4 B. A religious or philosophical exemption is available to an employee who states in
5 writing a sincere religious or philosophical belief that is contrary to the immunization
6 requirement of this subchapter.

7 **SUMMARY**

8 This bill reinstates the religious and philosophical exemptions from immunization
9 requirements for health care workers.
