1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 35-A MRSA §120, sub-§4**, as amended by PL 2009, c. 122, §8, is repealed.

3 **Sec. 2. 35-A MRSA §120, sub-§7**, as enacted by PL 2009, c. 122, §11, is amended  
4 to read:

5 **7. Other.** All other subjects that the commission is required to include in the annual  
6 report pursuant to law-, including but not limited to the following provisions:

7 A. Title 25, section 2927, subsection 5;

8 B. Section 3144, subsection 5;

9 C. Section 3195, subsection 5;

10 D. Section 3214, subsection 6;

11 E. Section 3217, subsection 4;

12 F. Section 4706, subsection 9;

13 G. Section 4706-B, subsection 4; and

14 H. Section 6102-A, subsection 2.

15 **Sec. 3. 35-A MRSA §1911**, as amended by PL 2015, c. 445, §7, is repealed.

16 **Sec. 4. 35-A MRSA §3143, sub-§9**, as enacted by PL 2009, c. 539, §2, is repealed.

17 **Sec. 5. 35-A MRSA §3217, sub-§1**, as amended by PL 2009, c. 122, §15, is  
18 repealed.

22 This bill updates the Public Utilities Commission's annual reporting requirements to  
23 remove outdated provisions and includes cross-references to certain specific reporting  
24 requirements for clarity.
