COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 145, L.D. 224, "An Act to Strengthen Maine's Health Care Workforce by Preventing Discrimination by Requiring Maintenance of Certification for Insurance Reimbursement"

Amend the bill in section 1 in §4303-G in subsection 2 in paragraph D in the first line (page 1, line 28 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "insurance empanelment" and inserting the following: 'credentialing'

Amend the bill in section 1 in §4303-G by inserting after subsection 2 the following:

'3. Repeal. This section is repealed April 1, 2029.'

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment is the majority report of the committee. The amendment changes terminology used in the bill to maintain consistency with language used in other provisions of the Maine Insurance Code. The amendment also adds a provision to repeal the bill's requirements on April 1, 2029.
