3	6. Substance use disorder. If substance use disorder is a factor in the cause or
4	proximate cause of death, the certificate must include substance use disorder as a factor in
5	the cause or proximate cause of the death and identify the substance underlying the
6	disorder.
7	SUMMARY
8	This bill requires that if substance use disorder is a factor in the cause or the proximate
9	cause in the death of a person, the death certificate must include substance use disorder as
10	a factor in the cause or proximate cause of the death and identify the substance underlying
11	the disorder.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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
