Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following  
**'An Act to Establish the Pink-edged Sulphur as the State Butterfly'**

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting the following

**'Sec. 1. 1 MRSA §231** is enacted to read

**§231. State butterfly**

The Pink-edged Sulphur (Colias interior) is the official state butterfly'

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively
