COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S P 126, L D 267, "An Act to Require Private Insurance Coverage for Donor Breast Milk"

Amend the bill in section 1 in §4320-V by striking out all of subsection 2 (page 1, lines 24 to 26 in L D)

Amend the bill by inserting after section 2 the following

'Sec. 3. Exemption from mandate review. Notwithstanding the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 24-A, section 2752, this Act is enacted without review and evaluation by the Department of Professional and Financial Regulation, Bureau of Insurance '

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively

SUMMARY

This amendment, which is the majority report of the committee, removes the provision in the bill that prohibits cost-sharing for donor breast milk. The amendment also exempts the health insurance requirements for coverage of donor breast milk from a review and evaluation by the Department of Professional and Financial Regulation, Bureau of Insurance pursuant to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 24-A, section 2752
