1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. Appropriations and allocations.** The following appropriations and
3 allocations are made.

4 **EDUCATION, DEPARTMENT OF**

5 **General Purpose Aid for Local Schools 0308**

6 Initiative: Provides one-time funds for scholarships for descendants of former residents of
7 Malaga Island or members of a federally recognized Indian tribe in the State. The
8 Commissioner of Education shall award these funds to a nonprofit entity to administer the
9 scholarship program.

15 This bill provides one-time funds for scholarships for descendants of former residents
