Initiative: Provides one-time funding to the Department of Health and Human Services, Office of Child and Family Services to enhance current programs and develop new programs geographically dispersed across the State that provide at-risk youth and youth involved in the juvenile justice system low-barrier access to shelters, youth centers, comprehensive needs assessments and wraparound services.
