1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2 3	Sec. 1. 26 MRSA §637, sub-§1, ¶C, as enacted by PL 2019, c. 156, §3 and affected by §4, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:
4	C. "Employee" means a person engaged in employment but does not include:
5 6	(1) A person employed by a school administrative unit as a substitute teacher of in another substitute position, as a coach or as a temporary employee; or
7 8	(2) A part-time or temporary employee in a retail trade or a service-related industry.
9	SUMMARY
10 11 12 13	This bill exempts substitute teachers, other substitute employees, coaches and temporary employees in school administrative units and part-time or temporary employees in a retail trade or a service-related industry from being covered by the law that requires employers to offer earned paid leave to employees.
