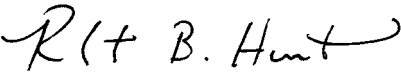

4 This bill is a concept draft pursuant to Joint Rule 208.

5 This bill would direct the Department of Health and Human Services to increase the
6 rates in rule Chapter 101: MaineCare Benefits Manual, Chapter III, Section 65, Behavioral
7 Health Services, for medication management, home and community-based treatment,
8 multi-systemic therapy and functional family therapy and Section 17, Allowances for
9 Community Support Services, for assertive community treatment.
