SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S P 146, LD 325, "An Act to Improve Consideration of Electricity Rate Increases"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in §302 in subsection 1-A by inserting after paragraph C the following

"D" "Grassroots lobbying" has the same meaning as in Title 3, section 312-A, subsection 7-B

E "Lobbying" has the same meaning as in Title 3, section 312-A, subsection 9'

Amend the amendment in section 1 in §302 in subsection 1-A by inserting after paragraph D the following

"E" "Trade association" means a group of for-profit corporations collaborating to fund joint advocacy'

Amend the amendment in section 1 in §302 in subsection 1-A by relettering the paragraphs to read alphabetically

Amend the amendment in section 1 in §302 in subsection 2 in paragraph B in the first line (page 2, line 1 in amendment) by inserting after the following "to a" the following 'trade association, chamber of commerce or'

Amend the amendment in section 1 in §302 in subsection 2 in paragraph B in the last line (page 2, line 3 in amendment) by striking out the following "and"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in §302 in subsection 2 by inserting after paragraph B the following

'C Expenditures for lobbying or grassroots lobbying, and'

Amend the bill in section 1 in §302 in subsection 2 by relettering the paragraphs to read alphabetically

Amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively


