1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §6502 is enacted to read:
3	§6502. Access to menstrual products
4 5 6 7	A school administrative unit shall require its schools that serve students in any of grades 6 to 12 to make available menstrual products to students at no cost in all school bathrooms. For purposes of this section, "menstrual products" means tampons and sanitary pads used with respect to menstruation.
