Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §8052, sub-§1, as amended by PL 2007, c. 581, §2, is further
amended to read:

Notice; public hearing. Prior to the adoption of any rule, the agency shall give
notice as provided in section 8053 and may hold a public hearing, except that a public
hearing must be held if otherwise required by statute or requested by any 5 interested
persons or if the rule is a and all rules adopted under this chapter are considered major
substantive rule rules as defined in section 8071, subsection 2, paragraph B.

9 A public meeting or other public forum held by an agency for any purpose that includes 10 receiving public comments on a proposed agency rule is a public hearing and is subject to 11 all the provisions of this subchapter regarding public hearings.

12 Sec. 2. Revisor's review; cross-references. The Revisor of Statutes shall review 13 the Maine Revised Statutes and include in the errors and inconsistencies bill submitted to 14 the Second Regular Session of the 131st Legislature pursuant to Title 1, section 94 any 15 sections necessary to correct and update any cross-references in the statutes to provisions 16 of law repealed in this Act.

This bill changes the designation of all rules adopted pursuant to the MaineAdministrative Procedure Act to major substantive rules.
