1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 14 MRSA §6030-H is enacted to read:
3 4	§6030-H. State law or municipal ordinance imposing moratorium for nonpayment of rent
5 6 7 8	If the State enacts a law or a municipality enacts an ordinance imposing a moratorium on evictions of tenants from rental property for nonpayment of rent, the State or that municipality shall reimburse a landlord for rental income not received for the duration of the moratorium.
9	SUMMARY
10 11 12	This bill requires the State or a municipality to reimburse a landlord for rental income if the State or municipality enacts a law or ordinance imposing a moratorium on evictions of tenants from rental property for nonpayment of rent.
