

This bill requires the Department of Transportation (DOT), within available resources, to remove 31 miles of statowned inactive existing railroad track between the Town of Standish and the Town of Fryeburg and replace the t with an interim 10-foot wide bicycle and pedestrian trail. The cost to perform this work is estimated to be approximately \$20.1 million. If the DOT does not have sufficient available resources, the project may not move forward.
