Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §1728 is enacted to read:

§1728. Translator and translation

Except for in an emergency, a hospital shall make every effort to provide an appropriate adult translator for a patient of the hospital who cannot understand English. A hospital shall provide to a patient who cannot understand English any discharge instructions, any directions for a prescription medication or anything else the patient must sign in the course of the patient's treatment or as a condition of the patient's release in a language that the patient understands. For purposes of this section, "hospital" has the same meaning as in section 328, subsection 14.

11 SUMMARY

This bill requires hospitals to make every effort to provide an appropriate adult translator for a patient of the hospital who cannot understand English and to provide any discharge instructions, any directions for prescription medications or anything else the patient must sign in the course of the patient's treatment or as a condition of the patient's release in a language that the patient understands.
