1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2 3	Sec. 1. 35-A MRSA §3210, sub-§3, ¶A, as enacted by PL 2019, c. 477, §1, is amended to read:
4	A. For the purposes of meeting the portfolio requirement under this subsection, a 300%
5	multiplier is applied to the output of a generator fueled by municipal solid waste in
6	conjunction with recycling that has obtained a solid waste facility license from the
7	Department of Environmental Protection.
8	This paragraph is repealed January 1, 2025.
9	SUMMARY
10	This bill eliminates the January 1, 2025 repeal date on the Maine Revised Statutes,
11	Title 35-A, section 3210, subsection 3, paragraph A, a provision of law that applies a 300%
12	multiplier to the output of a generator fueled by municipal solid waste.
