An Act to Require the Recording of Grand Jury Proceedings

1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 15 MRSA §1256-A is enacted to read:
3	§1256-A. Recording of grand jury proceedings
4	Except while the grand jury is deliberating or voting:
5 6	A. All proceedings of the grand jury must be recorded by a court reporter or by a suitable recording device; and
7 8	B. A court reporter or operator of electronic recording equipment may be present for the purpose of making a recording as required by paragraph A.
9 10	An unintentional or inadvertent failure to record a grand jury's proceedings does not warrant the dismissal of any indictment returned by the grand jury.
11	SUMMARY
12 13 14	This bill requires the recording of all state grand jury proceedings, in the same manner and to the same extent as the proceedings of federal grand juries are required to be recorded under federal law.
