1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §81-B is enacted to read:
3	§81-B. Resignation required; candidacy in election
4 5 6 7	The Secretary of State shall resign from office if the Secretary of State becomes a candidate in any election. For purposes of this section, "any election" has the same meaning as in Title 21-A, section 1, subsection 2 and "candidate" has the same meaning as in Title 21-A, section 1, subsection 5.
8	SUMMARY
9 10	This bill requires the Secretary of State to resign from office if the Secretary of State becomes a candidate in any election.
