1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 23 MRSA §1912-C, sub-§5, ¶A, as enacted by PL 2013, c. 549, §3, is
3	amended by amending subparagraph (1) to read:
4	(1) Is located within $15 \underline{100}$ miles of an exit and has an enrollment of $300 \underline{200}$ or
5	more students attending classes on site; or
6	SUMMARY
7	This bill amends the law regarding a destination qualifying for supplemental guide
8	signs on the interstate system for a college or university by changing the qualifying location
9	of the college or university from an exit from within 15 miles to within 100 miles and the
10	qualifying enrollment of the college or university from 300 or more to 200 or more students
11	attending classes on site.
