SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H P 331,
L D 526, "An Act to Provide Funding to Emergency Medical Services Organizations"

Amend the amendment by striking out the title and substituting the following

'An Act to Amend the Laws Governing the Emergency Medical Services Stabilization and Sustainability Program'

Amend the amendment by striking out all of the first instructional paragraph and emergency preamble

Amend the amendment by striking out all of sections 1 and 2 and inserting the following

'Sec. 1. 32 MRSA §98, sub-§1, ¶B, as enacted by PL 2023, c 412, Pt GGGGG, §1, is amended to read

B "Emergency medical services entity" means a nonprofit or for-profit an ambulance service or nontransporting emergency medical service or emergency medical services training center licensed under this chapter or a regional council '

Amend the amendment by striking out all of the first instructional paragraph on page 6 and the emergency clause

Amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively

Fiscal Detail and Notes

This amendment strikes the bill, including the one-time General Fund appropriation of \$31,000,000 in fiscal year 2023 24 for emergency medical services entities and replaces it with a statutory change to PL 2023, c 412, Part GGGGG that changes the definition of emergency medical services entity in the laws governing the Emergency Medical Services Stabilization and Sustainability Program established in PL 2023, c 412, Part GGGGG
