2 3	Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §4018, sub-§1, ¶A-1, as enacted by PL 2021, c. 466, §2, is amended by amending subparagraph (4) to read:
4 5 6 7 8 9	(4) In compliance with requirements adopted by rule by the department, including, but not limited to, a requirement that the device or container be equipped Equipped with an alarm that notifies the hospital, law enforcement agency or fire department where the device or container is located and a public safety answering point as defined in Title 25, section 2921, subsection 7 when a child is placed in the device or container.
10	Sec. 2. 22 MRSA §4018, sub-§6, as enacted by PL 2021, c. 466, §4, is repealed.
