1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2 3	Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §12051, sub-§1, ¶A, as repealed and replaced by PL 2013, c. 588, Pt. A, §16, is amended to read:
4 5	A. A person may train dogs on foxes, snowshoe hare, gray squirrels and raccoons from July 1st through the following March 31st, including Sundays.
6 7	Sec. 2. 12 MRSA §12051, sub-§3, as amended by PL 2011, c. 253, §22, is further amended to read:
8 9 10	3. Possessing firearm while training dogs. A person may not possess a firearm while training a dog outside of the open training season on foxes, snowshoe hare, gray squirrels and raccoons as set out in subsection 1, paragraph A.
11 12	A. A person who violates this subsection commits a civil violation for which a fine of not less than \$100 nor more than \$500 may be adjudged.
13 14 15	B. A person who violates this subsection after having been adjudicated as having committed 3 or more civil violations under this Part within the previous 5-year period commits a Class E crime.
16	SUMMARY
17 18	This bill adds gray squirrels to the list of those animals upon which a person may train dogs during the open training season for dogs.
