2	Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §5122, sub-§2, ¶AAA is enacted to read:
3 4 5	AAA. For taxable years beginning on or after January 1, 2024, overtime pay received by an employee that is required to be paid by an employer under Title 26, section 664, subsection 3.
6	SUMMARY
7 8	This bill excludes overtime pay from income tax if the employer is required by law to pay the overtime to the employee.
