1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

- **Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §12458, sub-§3** is enacted to read:
- 3. Washington County rivers. A person may not be limited in the number, amount, weight or size of largemouth bass or smallmouth bass fished in the rivers of Washington County. A person may not be limited in the possession of largemouth bass or smallmouth bass fished in the rivers of Washington County. For purposes of this subsection, the rivers of Washington County include, but are not limited to, all or portions of Dennys River, St. Croix River, Machias River, East Machias River, Pleasant River, Narraguagus River, Union River, Tunk Stream and Orange River.
- **Sec. 2. 12 MRSA §12602, sub-§1,** as amended by PL 2017, c. 150, §5, is further amended to read:
- 1. Fish in violation of certain rules. Fish in violation of the number, amount, weight or size limits established by rules adopted by the commissioner, except that a person may not be limited in the number, amount, weight or size of largemouth bass or smallmouth bass fished in the rivers of Washington County, including, but not limited to, all or portions of Dennys River, St. Croix River, Machias River, East Machias River, Pleasant River, Narraguagus River, Union River, Tunk Stream and Orange River;
- **Sec. 3. 12 MRSA §12602, sub-§2,** as amended by PL 2019, c. 224, §1, is further amended to read:
- **2. Possess fish in violation of certain rules.** Possess fish in violation of the number, amount, weight or size limits established by rules adopted by the commissioner, except that a person may not be limited in the possession of largemouth bass or smallmouth bass fished in the rivers of Washington County, including, but not limited to, all or portions of Dennys River, St. Croix River, Machias River, East Machias River, Pleasant River, Narraguagus River, Union River, Tunk Stream and Orange River;

26 SUMMARY

This bill removes the limit on the number, amount, weight and size of largemouth bass and smallmouth bass fished in the rivers of Washington County. The bill also removes the limit on possessing largemouth bass or smallmouth bass fished in the rivers of Washington County. The bill specifies that the rivers of Washington County include, but are not limited to, all or portions of Dennys River, St. Croix River, Machias River, East Machias River, Pleasant River, Narraguagus River, Union River, Tunk Stream and Orange River.
