Proceeds from the sale of the Houlton Armory will be credited to the Capital Repair, Maintenance, Construction and Acquisition Account within the Department of Defense, Veterans and Emergency Management. Additional costs to the department associated with the appraisal are expected to be minor and can be absorbed within existing budgeted resources.
