2	Sec. 1. 15 MRSA §815, as amended by PL 2021, c. 668, §1, is repealed.
3	SUMMARY
4 5 6 7 8	This bill repeals the provision of the Maine Revised Statutes that generally prohibits a prosecutor from communicating with an unrepresented defendant concerning the facts, circumstances, merits or disposition of a pending criminal charge against that defendant unless the defendant has been notified by the court of the defendant's right to counsel and has executed in court a written waiver of the right to counsel.
