An Act to Increase Availability of Election Information on Local Government Websites

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 21-A MRSA §611 is enacted to read:

§611. Online access to election information

The Secretary of State, or the secretary's designee, shall develop and maintain a web page on the Secretary of State's publicly accessible website that includes general information on state and local elections. Upon request from a municipal or county official, the Secretary of State, or the secretary's designee, shall post on the web page a link to the municipal or county government's publicly accessible website or web page containing general information on state and local elections. Upon request from a municipal or county official, the Secretary of State, or the secretary's designee, shall provide a template of its web page for use by a municipal or county government.

12 SUMMARY

This bill requires the Secretary of State, or the secretary's designee, to: develop and maintain a web page on its publicly accessible website, with general information on state and local elections; include a link to municipal or county governments' publicly accessible websites or web pages containing general information on state and local elections; and provide a template of its web page to municipal and county governments.
