## An Act to Enhance Certain Penalties for Possession of Firearms by Prohibited Persons

27 28	<b>Sec. 7. 15 MRSA §393, sub-§1, ¶I,</b> as amended by PL 2015, c. 470, §1, is further amended to read:
29 30	I. Has been discharged from the United States Armed Forces under dishonorable conditions. Violation of this paragraph is a Class $\underline{PC}$ crime; or
31 32	<b>Sec. 8. 15 MRSA §393, sub-§1, ¶J,</b> as amended by PL 2015, c. 470, §1, is further amended to read:
33 34	J. Has, having been a citizen of the United States, renounced that person's citizenship. Violation of this paragraph is a Class $\underline{P} \underline{C}$ crime.
