1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 7 MRSA §3910-B, sub-§5** is enacted to read:

3 **5. Rules.** Pursuant to section 3906-B, subsection 10, the commissioner shall adopt
4 rules to carry out the purposes of this section. Rules adopted under this subsection are major
5 substantive rules under Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter 2-A.

6 **SUMMARY**

7 This bill requires the Commissioner of Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry to adopt
8 major substantive rules to administer the Companion Animal Sterilization Fund, also
9 known as the Help Fix ME program.
