### 1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

**Sec. 1. Appropriations and allocations.** The following appropriations and allocations are made.

#### HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES, DEPARTMENT OF

#### **Purchased Social Services 0228**

Initiative: Provides ongoing funding for the department to contract for support services for a transitional housing program in Portland that provides low-barrier, 24-hour, 7-day-a-week shelter, comprehensive case management and daily living support services to individuals experiencing homelessness who also have medical, mental health or substance use-related needs. This appropriation would be in addition to any of the current MaineCare program funding already provided for other services.
