1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 20-A MRS §4001, sub-§8** is enacted to read:

3 **8. Green schools coordinator.** There is created within the department the position of
4 green schools coordinator. The green schools coordinator is responsible for assisting
5 department staff and other relevant stakeholders in establishing school facility priorities
6 and working with school administrative units regarding building weatherization and
7 modification for the use of renewable energy resources.

9 This bill creates the position of green schools coordinator within the Department of
10 Education to assist department staff and other relevant stakeholders in establishing school
11 facility priorities and working with school administrative units regarding building
12 weatherization and modification for the use of renewable energy resources.
