18 out the following "Part" and inserting the following 'Act'

19 Amend the bill in Part A in section 7 in the 3rd line (page 1, line 31 in L D) by striking
20 out the following "Part" and inserting the following 'Act'

21 Amend the bill in Part A by inserting after section 7 the following
22 'Sec. A-8. Exemption from mandate review. Notwithstanding the Maine Revised
23 Statutes, Title 24-A, section 2752, this Act is enacted without review and evaluation by the
24 Department of Professional and Financial Regulation, Bureau of Insurance '

25 Amend the bill by striking out all of Part B

26 Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section
27 number to read consecutively

28 SUMMARY

29 This amendment, which is the minority report of the committee, exempts the health
30 insurance requirements in the bill for coverage of circumcision from a review and
31 evaluation by the Department of Professional and Financial Regulation, Bureau of
32 Insurance pursuant to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 24-A, section 2752
