1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §9325, sub-§2, ¶A**, as enacted by PL 1991, c. 36, §4, is amended
3 to read:

4 A. ~~Recreational campfires~~ Any burning or fire under subsection 1 kindled when the
5 ground is covered by snow or on frozen bodies of water;

6 **SUMMARY**

7 Current law requires a permit for certain types of burning and fires. This bill exempts
8 those types of burning and fires from needing a permit if kindled on ground covered by
9 snow or on frozen bodies of water.
