2	Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §1830, sub-§13 is enacted to read:
3 4 5 6 7 8	13. Battery electric vehicle purchases or leases. In addition to the requirements of subsection 12, the Central Fleet Management Division and the Department of Public Safety shall purchase or lease only battery electric vehicles to the extent a battery electric vehicle that meets the need for which the vehicle is being purchased or leased is commercially available. For purposes of this subsection, "battery electric vehicle" has the same meaning as in Title 35-A, section 10126, subsection 1, paragraph A.
