1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §1830, sub-§13** is enacted to read:

3 **13. Battery electric vehicle purchases or leases.** In addition to the requirements of
4 subsection 12, the Central Fleet Management Division and the Department of Public Safety
5 shall purchase or lease only battery electric vehicles to the extent a battery electric vehicle
6 that meets the need for which the vehicle is being purchased or leased is commercially
7 available. For purposes of this subsection, "battery electric vehicle" has the same meaning
8 as in Title 35-A, section 10126, subsection 1, paragraph A.

9 **SUMMARY**

10 Current law establishes certain goals for the Department of Administrative and
11 Financial Services, Bureau of General Services, Central Fleet Management Division and
12 the Department of Public Safety in acquiring by purchase or lease plug-in hybrid electric
13 vehicles and zero-emission vehicles. This bill provides, in addition, that the Central Fleet
14 Management Division and the Department of Public Safety must purchase or lease only
15 zero-emission battery electric vehicles, to the extent a battery electric vehicle that meets
16 the need for which the vehicle is being purchased or leased is commercially available.
