Amend the bill by striking out all of section 2 and inserting the following

'Sec. 2. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made

ARTS COMMISSION, MAINE

Public Art Fund Program N420

Initiative Provides one-time funds for grants to public entities for the installation or performance of art that is publicly accessible Funds appropriated for this purpose do not lapse but must be carried forward into the next fiscal year to be used for the same purpose
