Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 27 MRSA §410-B is enacted to read:

§410-B. Public Art Fund

There is established the Public Art Fund, an interest-bearing nonlapsing General Fund account, referred to in this section as "the fund." The fund is administered by the Maine Arts Commission. Money deposited in the fund and the earnings on that money remain in the fund to be used to provide a grant to a public entity, including a school, library or government office, that applies for a grant for the installation or performance of art that is publicly accessible. For the purposes of awarding grants, "public art" must be construed broadly, and may include a mural, sculpture, painting, audio or visual presentation, digital presentation, musical or theatrical performance, demonstration of or instruction in an activity or performing a task or lecture. A recipient of a grant under this section shall endeavor to contract or commission a provider, maker or performer of art that resides or is located in the State to the extent possible.

Sec. 2. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.

ARTS COMMISSION, MAINE

Public Art Fund Program N420

Initiative: Provides one-time funds for grants to public entities for the installation or performance of art that is publicly accessible. Funds appropriated for this purpose do not lapse but must be carried forward into the next fiscal year to be used for the same purpose.
