1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 14 MRSA §6030-H is enacted to read:
3	§6030-H. Application fees; prohibited
4 5 6 7 8	A landlord may not require a person to pay a fee to submit an application to enter into an agreement for rental of a dwelling unit or require a person to pay a fee for the landlord to review or approve an application to enter into an agreement for rental of a dwelling unit. As used in this section, "dwelling unit" has the same meaning as in section 6021, subsection <u>1</u> .

10 11	This bill prohibits a landlord from requiring a person to pay a fee in order to submit an application to enter into an agreement to rent a residential dwelling unit.
