1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: 2 **CONCEPT DRAFT** 3 **SUMMARY** 4 This bill is a concept draft pursuant to Joint Rule 208. 5 This bill proposes to direct the Public Utilities Commission to examine its previous reports made pursuant to the Maine Energy Cost Reduction Act on the status and future of 6 the natural gas supply in the State and, using current natural gas supply information as well 7 as future projections, submit a report of the commission's findings and recommendations 8 to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over energy, utilities 9 10 and technology matters.
