1 2	<b>Emergency preamble. Whereas,</b> acts and resolves of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and
3 4	<b>Whereas,</b> this legislation needs to take effect immediately in order to establish an annual sales tax holiday weekend beginning in August 2023.
5 6 7 8	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,
9	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
10	Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §1760, sub-§115 is enacted to read:
11 12 13	115. Annual sales tax holiday weekend. Sales of tangible personal property for the 4 days annually beginning at 12:01 a.m. of the 3rd Friday before Labor Day until 11:59 p.m. of the 4th day.
14 15	<b>Emergency clause.</b> In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this legislation takes effect when approved.
16	SUMMARY
17	This bill establishes an annual 4-day sales tax holiday beginning in August 2023.
