An Act to Add an Adult Education Pathway to a High School Diploma

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §257, sub-§1, ¶A, as amended by PL 2017, c. 381, §1, is further amended by amending subparagraph (2) to read:

(2) Has demonstrated, through procedures prescribed by the commissioner, attainment of a general educational development comparable to that of a secondary school graduate; or

Sec. 2. 20-A MRSA §257, sub-§1, ¶F is enacted to read:

F. Has completed the required adult education courses prescribed by the commissioner within 4 years of beginning high school.

Sec. 3. 20-A MRSA §8602, as amended by PL 1991, c. 518, §34, is further amended to read:

§8602. Rules

The commissioner may adopt rules to establish requirements for adult education courses, to establish procedures for approving adult education courses offered by units, regions or centers, establish adult education requirements to achieve a high school equivalency diploma and to otherwise carry out the purposes of this chapter.

SUMMARY

This bill requires the Commissioner of Education to issue a high school equivalency diploma to an adult education student who has met requirements prescribed by the commissioner.
