| 4 5 6 7 8 9 10 | A contract with the State in an amount over $500,000$ must include a clause that prohibits the other contracting party, including a person, corporation, union or nonprofit corporation, from engaging in any effort to influence an election in the State through a contribution to a candidate, a political action committee, a political party or a political organization registered as a tax-exempt organization under 26 United States Code, Section 501(c)(4). The period of the prohibition under this section must be for the duration of the contract plus 2 years. |

| 12 13 14 15 16 | This bill requires that every contract with the State in an amount over $500,000$ have a clause that prohibits the other contracting party from influencing state elections through contributions to a candidate, a political action committee, a political party or a political organization that is a tax-exempt organization under 26 United States Code, Section $501(c)(4)$ for the duration of the contract plus 2 years. |
