COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S P 298, L D 740, "An Act to Clarify the Criteria for State Approval of Alcoholic Beverage Container Labels"

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 2-A by striking out all of paragraph B (page 1, lines 14 and 15 in L D ) and inserting the following

'B The label does not contain a subject matter or an illustration that targets minors '

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively

**SUMMARY**

This amendment, which is the unanimous report of the committee, changes the language regarding labels and minors to remove the phrase "that induces a minor to drink or that depicts an individual in the act of drinking liquor" to read "that targets minors "
