1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2 3	Sec. 1. 21-A MRSA §682, sub-§2, as amended by PL 2019, c. 371, §21, is further amended by amending the first blocked paragraph to read:
4 5 6 7	These limitations do This subsection does not prohibit apply to a candidate from attending, who may attend the voting place and orally communicating communicate with voters as long as the candidate does not attempt to influence their vote. A candidate may not state the name of the office sought or request a person's vote.
8	SUMMARY
9 10	This bill removes the restrictions on candidate speech while engaging with voters at a voting place.
