COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “ A ” to S.P. 309, L.D. 751, “An Act to Clarify the Powers of a Conservator to Transfer Property”

Amend the bill in section 1 in paragraph B in the first line (page 1, line 4 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "sign" the following: 'or revoke'

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

The bill authorizes a conservator to sign a transfer on death deed for the primary dwelling of the individual subject to the conservatorship, with court approval. This amendment, which is the majority report of the committee, also authorizes a conservator to revoke a transfer on death deed for the primary dwelling of the individual subject to the conservatorship, with court approval.
