COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to SP 315, LD 757 (S-ZB)

SUMMARY

This amendment replaces the bill with a resolve directing the Department of Health and Human Services to review its MaineCare reimbursement of telemonitoring services and of ultrasound procedures and fetal nonstress tests performed remotely in a residence or other off-site location through telehealth. The amendment also requires the department to submit its recommendations to the Joint Standing Committee on Health and Human Services by January 10, 2024. The committee may report out legislation related to the department's report to the Second Regular Session of the 131st Legislature
