SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S P 323, L D 764 (S-4/15)

'Sec. 1. Effective date. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, bills enacted during the First Special Session of the 131st Legislature that are direct initiatives of legislation pursuant to the Constitution of Maine, Article IV, Part Third, Section 18 and are identified as LD 1610, "An Act to Prohibit Campaign Spending by Foreign Governments and Promote an Anticorruption Amendment to the United States Constitution," LD 1611, "An Act to Create the Pine Tree Power Company, a Nonprofit, Customer-owned Utility," and LD 1772, "An Act to Require Voter Approval of Certain Borrowing by Government-controlled Entities and Utilities and to Provide Voters More Information Regarding That Borrowing," have an effective date of January 1, 2024, unless the direct initiative provides for an effective date later than January 1, 2024, in which case the effective date in that direct initiative applies ' '

15 This amendment amends the committee amendment to clarify the nature of the 16 emergency in the bill and to provide details of the direct initiatives to which this legislation 17 applies It retains the substance of the committee amendment by specifying the legislation's 18 application to direct initiatives enacted during the First Special Session of the 131st 19 Legislature
