An Act to Prohibit Ballot Harvesting by Preventing a 3rd Person from Returning More than 2 Absentee Ballots per Day

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
<b>Sec. 1. 21-A MRSA §753-B, sub-§3,</b> as amended by PL 2001, c. 310, §52, is further amended to read:
3. Return of ballot by 3rd person. A 3rd person shall, unless good cause is shown return an absentee ballot to the clerk's office within 2 business days of the date that ballo was provided to the 3rd person or by the close of the polls on election day, whichever is earlier. The clerk shall inform the 3rd person of the deadline for the return of the ballot. And person may not return more than 2 absentee ballots per day.
